Never have I needed so little and been so at ease with myself as during those days with him. Eating, sleeping, loving, reading, working. It's as simple as that. And yet it's everything ...

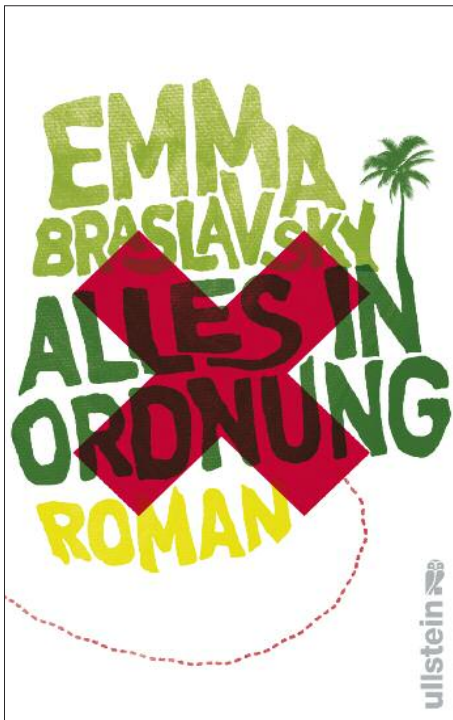

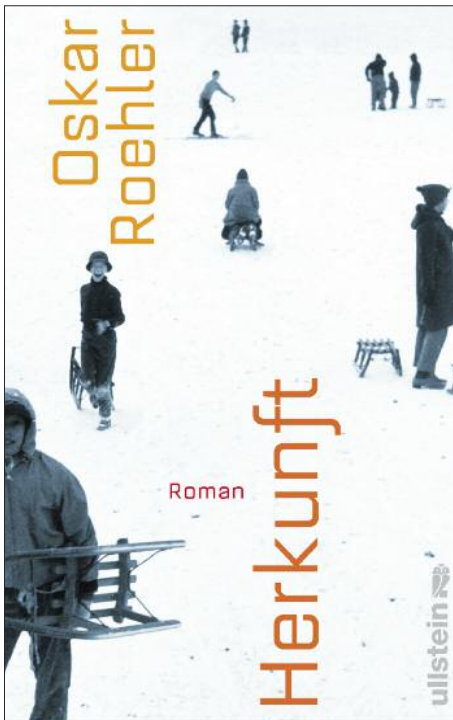

Emma Braslavsky fled communist East Germany via Hungary in 1989. She studied Russian, Italian and Southeast Asian studies. She has worked as a freelance writer and curator in Berlin since 1999. In 2005 she was awarded the *Berlin Literary Colloquium's Workshop Scholarship* in recognition of her work on her first novel **Aus dem Sinn** (Out of Mind), which was awarded the 2007 *Uwe Johnson Prize* and the *Franz Tumlér Prize* for best first novel. Her second novel, **Das Blaue vom Himmel über dem Atlantik** (Carnival Blues at an Eastern Wake), appeared in autumn 2008. Both works received enthusiastic review.

Sebastian was committed with the diagnosis manic depression. In his book he tells his eight-year-old son how the mental illness impacted his life and how he deals with it – brave, touching and honest.

He is considered a shooting star. At just 27 he is the musical director of the Schauspielhaus Hamburg theatre. But his success ends abruptly: Sebastian suffers from bipolar disorder. In the manic phase, he is a megalomaniac. He works day and night and nothing can stop him. In his depressive phases he cannot feel anything and is suicidal. Finally, he breaks down and realises: Something has to change.

This is the story of what happens to someone who is admitted into an institution, what it means to be mentally ill and how difficult it is to return to a normal life – a heartwarming book for everyone.

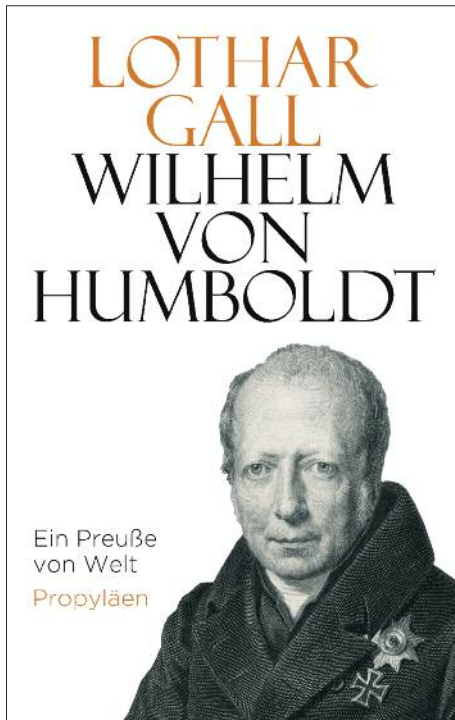

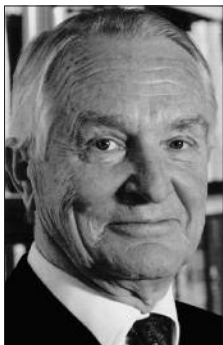

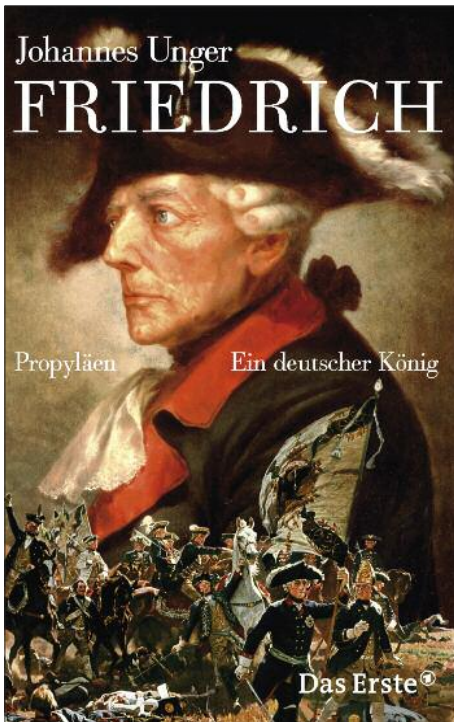

The battle for supremacy between the Habsburg Empire and the Kingdom of Prussia

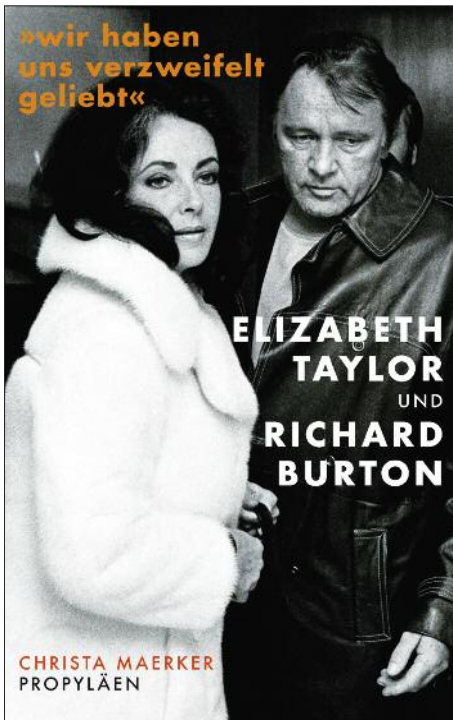
When Frederick the Great turned Prussia into a major European power, the stage was set for an epic battle between the Habsburg Empire and the upstart Prussian Kingdom for supremacy in Germany. Historian Ulrich Schlie traces the many vicissitudes of this dramatic dual at the heart of Europe, with the help of five biographical double portraits.

It begins with the seizure of Silesia by Frederick the Great, taking the great Habsburg Empress Maria Theresia by surprise. At the Congress of Vienna, the Prussian Chancellor Hardenberg and the Habsburg Foreign Minister Metternich wrestled for predominance in post-Napoleonic Germany. Bismarck and Schwarzenberg, too, disagreed about how to solve the German question. What followed was the fateful alliance of convenience between the German Emperor Wilhelm II and Franz Joseph I of Austria, which eventually led to the First World War and the downfall of both empires. The final end was marked by Hitler's annexation of his native country.
